The Need

Societies are justifiably judged by the way they treat their children. Yet throughout the world, from New York City to London, children go hungry, are undereducated and are poorly treated.

The Response

The Children's Global Network Foundation was founded in response to this crisis in the lives of children. Founder Mark Hallim visited Guatemala on a business trip in 1996 and wound up spending most of his visit helping a homeless family he encountered back to its feet. Upon his return to the United States, this banker began the process of developing a foundation to help address the needs of children -focusing on the areas of healthcare, housing and education.

The Children's Global Network Foundation

The Children's Global Network Foundation's long-term goal is to fund organizations whose primary focus and goal is to provide high-quality educational and cultural activities to underprivileged children throughout the world. It is essential that all children have this access if they are to compete and flourish in the increasingly demanding global community.

To ensure that funding is directed to appropriate organizations, the Foundation will create a database of community based, non-profit organizations and non-governmental organizations that help children. While clearly not able to create a globally exhaustive database, this slice of the world's services will allow the Foundation to choose a series of organizations every year that can serve as models for others. Organizations that are addressing the dire needs of young people and their families in innovative ways should be recognized for their efforts and supported in their efforts to let others know what they are doing.

2004 Goals

Calendar Year 2004 will be the Children's Global Network Foundation's first full year in existence, and will see the first disbursement of funds to agencies engaged in service to young people. The financial support of individuals, corporations, foundations and government agencies will make our work possible. By combining all revenue sources, the Foundation will be able to support two to five organizations in 2004 -- focusing in New York City and London for the first year.

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The first three organizations to receive support in the USA will be Clearpool, Inc., The Soho Center and The CityKids Foundation.

1. Clearpool, Inc. is a hundred year old institution providing children with an enriching multicultural experience and engaging thousands of children annually in a rigorous, hands-on curriculum for 10 hours per day, 11 months of the year, on 2 campuses and with 2 teachers and no more than 20 students in each class.
2. The Soho Center offers a variety of child-related programs including promoting early literacy and school success, affecting children's nutrition and enhancing the quality of childcare.
3. The CityKids Foundation's mission is to engage and develop diverse young people to effect positive change in their lives, their communities and the world. Founded in 1985, today The CityKids Foundation is one of the nation's leading providers of leadership training programs and services for youth. At its core, CityKids focuses on the development of young people. In an organization that is multicultural and youth-driven, they educate, train, and empower young people to produce solutions to problems they identify as pressing in their lives.

The organization in the UK to receive support will be Children in Crisis founded by the Duchess of York in 1993.

1. Children in Crisis exists to improve the lives of children around the world affected by conflict, deprivation, poverty or other hidden crises by working with local communities to provide education, healthcare and protection. We are awaiting approval to support other major UK charities.

The Children's Global Network Foundation recognizes that the task of meeting the needs of children on a global scale is daunting beyond compare. Therefore, our goal is to begin in New York City and London by supporting and recognizing a select group of agencies whose services are clearly exemplary. These agencies will receive both financial support and publicity, and will be covered extensively on the Foundation Website. As the Foundation grows in the years to come, we anticipate broadening the selection of agencies on an international level. The result will be a diverse network of children's service organization that are supported by the Foundation and whose work can serve as an inspiration both to others within in the network and the many other agencies throughout the world seeking innovative and proven means of supporting children.

Proving Our Impact

The Foundation's annual report will include a reporting of the impact that our investment has had at the organizations we support. This way, our investors will be able to see clearly that they can make a change in the world by investing wisely in quality programs through the Foundation. The Foundation also has an extremely low overhead, so the funds will go directly where they are needed the most -to children in the classrooms and clubs supported by the Foundation. Funds will be raised and disbursed globally. Funds raised in each country will be disbursed to local organizations. This will ensure that each country build their own network of individuals, corporations, foundations and governmental agencies so that the Foundation can operate as a local entity.

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J. Roldan

J.Roldan was born in Medellin Colombia in 1970, the grandson of Jesus Jimenez founder of the Colombian Philharmonic Orchestra. Thanks to his rich cultural background, J.Roldan began his artistic training at "Instituto De Bellas Artes". Following his education in 'Bellas Artes' he apprenticed for Francisco Ruiz a renowned Colombian artist.

J.Roldan moved to New York city in 1986 where he continued his studies at the Fashion Institute of Technology (F.I.T.) After graduating from F.I.T. , he continued to explore the arts by enrolling in NYU in the New University Program for film in 1989 and the Arts Student League in 1990. After attending these prestigious American art schools, J.Roldan moved to London in 1995 where he furthered his studies at the Kensington and Chelsea College and the Slade School of Arts.

By exploring contemporary issues, J.Roldan transforms the plain canvas into a collage of found imagery and artistic expression on his work. J.Roldan investigates issues of exploitation and fantasy by way of strong expressionistic strokes of colour whilst incorporating images taken directly from publications of popular culture.

J.Roldan is currently working and living in the UK, his work has featured in international exhibit in such galleries as Well Hung, the Air Gallery in London, La Cave de la Place de L'echo in France, Gallery 24, Sky Light 6 Gallery and KC Galleries in New York City.
